In my Ammo Burrito thread another member asked how I did my corners and kept them neat looking.



I am using a Brother Home Machine with no attachments and a box of small binder clips.

Here are some step by step pics on how to get neat corners without two extra hands:

Start by clamping right at the edge of the corner.



Bend the binding around the corner and clamp on the other side.



Use a narrow item to assist in tucking in the corners.



Do the same underneath.



Apply a clip to the corner to hold the tuck.



Sew up to the corner.



Remove the clip when the presser foot is close enough to hold the fold.



Sew into the corner. I like to backstitch in the corner for some added reinforcement. Lift the presser foot, turn the corner and sew on.



I hope this helps anyone who doesn't have any of the cool attachments. I still have a lot to learn, but I am happy to share what I figured out.
