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HOWTO: Make a Barrel Sock

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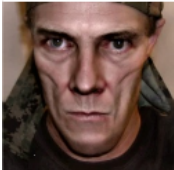

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HOWTO: Make a Barrel Sock

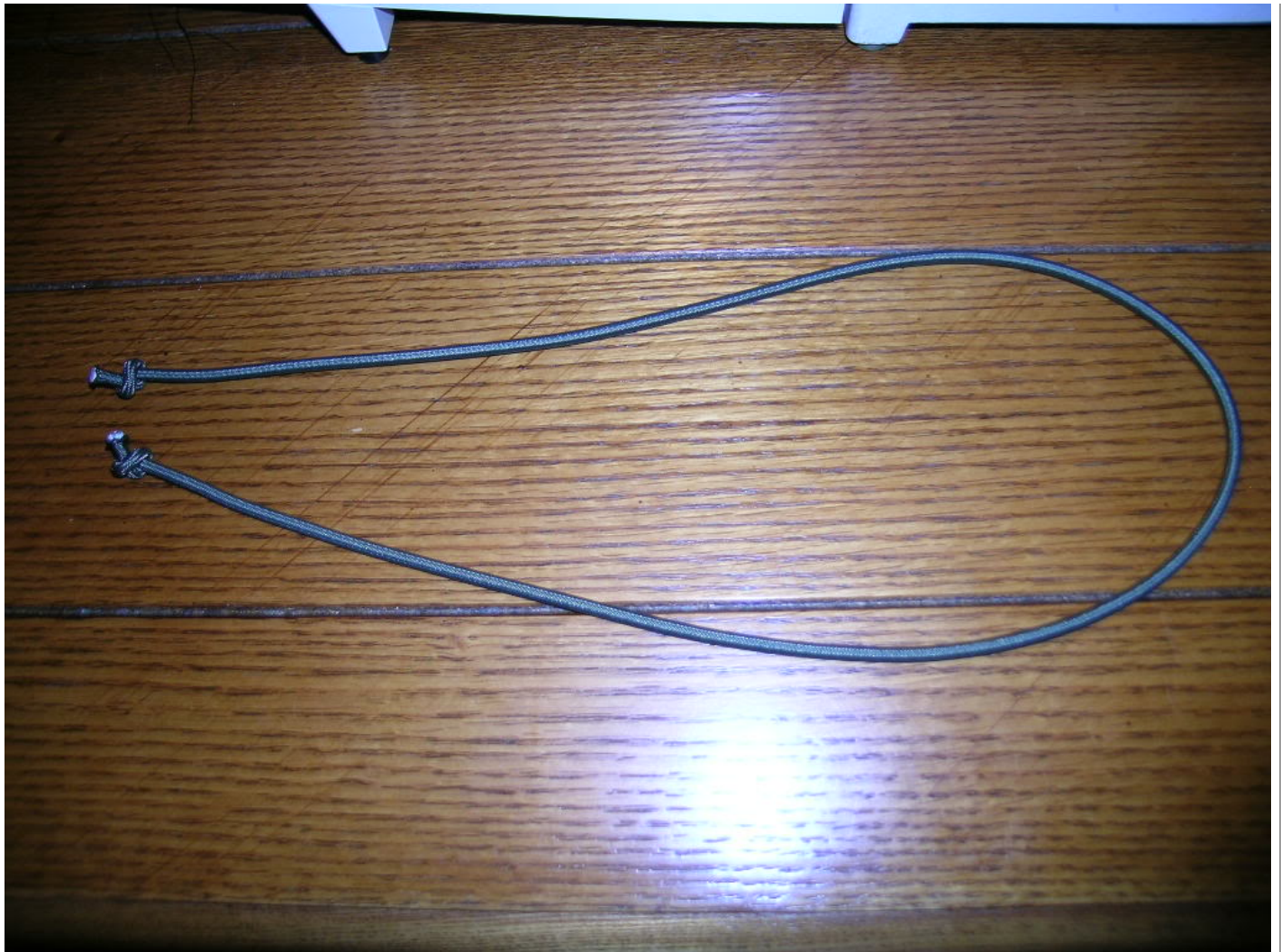
I recently picked up some OD green 1000D and some Tiger Stripe blend material. My last batch of Barrel Socks left much to desire, so I decided to do them up right. Tiger stripe is my team's color in case you are wondering. Here's my howto on making a barrel sock.

Materials

Heavy Duty Thread
Sewing Needle or sewing machine
Material of choice - I used OD green 1000D and Tiger stripe(blend)
About 33" of shock Cord
Scissors

1. Cut the OD Green 1000D to a size of 6.5" x 13" 2. Cut the Accent material(Tiger Stripe) to 6.5" x 7"





3. Hem the 6.5" sides of both pieces of material Make sure you sew close to the loose end of the accent material. You will see why in the next few steps.



4. Center the accent material on the OD green material



5. Sew the accent material to the OD green. To make it look clean, stitch on the outside of the material parallel to the previous stitch.



6. Flip the whole thing inside out and stitch along the edge .5 to .75 inches in. Be sure to sew the shock cord in as shown.





7. Flip it right side out and you're done!
